Employers are required to provide suitable duties to enable an injured worker to recover at work.

This portfolio can be utilised by the organisation when required to offer suitable duties to an injured employee. Providing the details of the task analysis to an injured employees' treating Doctor, facilitates the approval of a return to work program, minimising the delay of a safe return to work.
